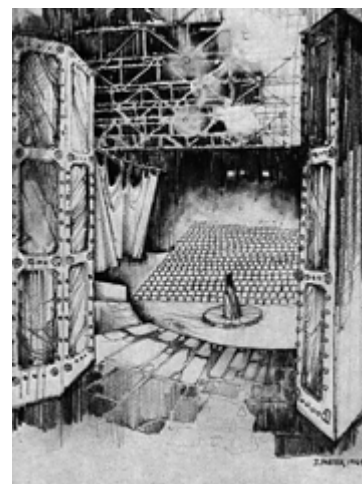


## A Place For The Arts

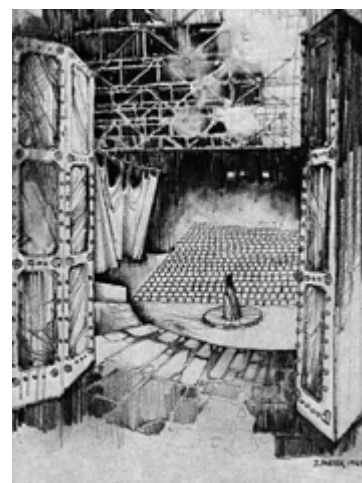
