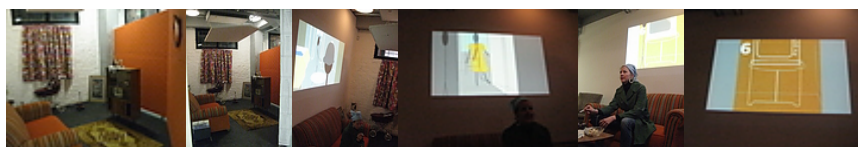


Married in Black
